









### **Expert Group on Urban Mobility**

- The **Expert Group on Urban Mobility (EGUM)** is a platform for dialogue and the co-creation of new actions to implement the new EU urban mobility framework, set up in July 2022 by COM(2022) 5320.
- It includes 77 members: Member States, cities & regions, stakeholder associations, industry.
- During the period 2023-2024 the group produced **reports** on 6 topics: sustainable urban mobility planning, urban vehicle access regulations, public transport and shared mobility, active mobility and safety of vulnerable road users, future of urban space and mobility (all available at: <a href="https://transport.ec.europa.eu/transport-themes/urban-transport/expert-group-urban-mobility">https://transport.ec.europa.eu/transport-themes/urban-transport/expert-group-urban-mobility</a> en)
- EGUM Work Programme 2025 will focus on 3 new topics, with dedicated subgroups:
  - Urban nodes Cooperation between cities and stakeholders of their Functional Urban Area (FUA)
  - City access for businesses
  - Implementation of the European Declaration on Cycling



## **Urban Mobility Indicators**

- Ad-hoc working group of the TEN-T Committee, with meetings between October 2024
   April 2025.
- Topics: safety, sustainability, accessibility, horizontal indicators and geographical coverage of the data.
- Next meeting will be on 2 April.
- Have your say public consultation: May-June 2025.
- TEN-T committee adopts opinion on Implementing Act: September 2025.
- Translation of draft Implementing Act: September-October 2025.
- Commission adopts the Implementing Act: October-November 2025.











## **National SUMP Support Programmes (NSSPs)**

- Third NSSP workshop with national SUMP contact points: Prague, 3-4 April.
- EU platform for national SUMP contact points: 1st meeting over next 2-3 months (date tbc)

## Multimodal passenger hubs study

- Deliverables: database of multimodal passenger hubs per urban node; expert report; 20 case studies.
- Final report: due by the end of June.











## **Update of SUMP Guidelines**

- An update has begun within the framework of the Urban Mobility Observatory contract, with a mature draft expected by June.
- The next version will be available in time for the Urban Mobility Days conference (end Sept).


## **Update of SUMP reference materials**
